Details about the activities:

Wednesday (cybersecurity workshop):

- students learn computer language by playing online games on their mobile phones, next they practice computer language in international teams via card games (outcome: students know basic computer language)
- students in international teams do online quizzes, games and activities about cybersecurity, personal data protection, Internet safety and cyberbullying prevention (outcomes: students know which online activities are safe and which should be avoided, students are able to recognise behaviours typically related to cyberbullying and know how to react to them, students know the names of typical negative phenomena related to using social media and online resources, students are able to recognise the typical behaviours of Internet aggression behaviours and know how to react)

Thursday: (all activities in international teams - grade 7 students from our school and your students)

Nature House - workshops with **ICT, smartphones and interactive touch screens about the plants and wild animals of Silesian Region**, elements of the regional history - how people lived in the past (outcomes: students know what fauna and flora are related to Silesian Region, they know which animals are protected and they are able to give basic information about the history of the region, they know how to use ICT for recognising plants)
After that the students will hand-make ecology bags with the use of regional plants (floral patterns)

STODOŁA cultural center - online webquest with **ICT about the region** - students need to follow interactive map to discover information about our region (outcome: students know details about the region and know how to use ICT devices for problem solving and selective use of online information)

Entrance tickets: (estimated costs – only if you want to go – we can also see it only from the outside or choose some places)

Kraków: mind that all the tickets must be purchased online in advance as in June it can get crowded with tourists

10 zł - ticket to Collegium Maius - the oldest Polish University dating back to medieval times

Wawel Cathedral, Royal Tombs and Sigismund Bell - 17 zł / per person

St. Mary's Basilica - (the wooden altar by Wit Stwosz opens at 11.50 and closes at 18.00.) - 15 zł / per person or free of charge

Tower of Basilica: 20 zł / per person
